National Electronic Attachment, Inc (NEA) Signs Agreement with Dental Network of America (DNoA) to process Dental Attachments Electronically, via FastAttach™

Atlanta, Georgia – National Electronic Attachment, Inc. (NEA) of Atlanta, GA announced today that they have signed an Agreement with Dental Network of America (DNoA). DNoA will begin accepting dental electronic attachments transmitted to NEA's web site from providers using NEA's *FastAttach™* system.

FastAttach™ enables a healthcare office to transmit attachments (x-rays, perio charts, intra-oral pictures, narratives, referral slips, lab reports, EOB's, etc), via the Internet, to NEA's repository where Insurance Payors are able to view them, in support of electronic claims.
